2023 Women Investing in Women Grants

To provide funding to women entrepreneurs in Oneida and Herkimer Counties, Purpose:

to enable them to grow their businesses. We are offering four grants of up to \$5,000 each.

Eligibility: Applications will be considered from businesses that:

- Are at least 51% woman-owned
- Are based in Oneida County and/or Herkimer County, New York
- Have been in existence for at least one year with plans to improve/expand

Examples of what we will fund:

- Equipment
- Hardware/Software
- Consulting services
- Training/education
- Marketing

What we will not fund:

- Ongoing operating expenses (salaries, bonuses, rent, etc.)
- Religious or political businesses
- Debt reduction/loan expenses
- Already incurred expenses

Other guidelines:

- Only one request will be accepted per business
- Previous winners must wait 12 months to reapply
- Request must not exceed \$5,000
- Funded project must be complete within 12 months of award
- Grant Deadline Friday, September 29, 2023
